



Configuring Other Wi-Fi Devices to Use Wireless PittNet

Overview

This help sheet explains how to configure the following types of wi-fi devices to use Wireless PittNet:

- Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs)
- Smart phones
- BlackBerry devices
- Other handheld wi-fi devices
- Laptop computers running the Linux operating system
- Laptop computers that use a third-party wireless client (for example, an Intel client or a Gateway client)

Configuring Your Wi-Fi Device to Use Wireless PittNet

Computing Services and Systems Development supports general connectivity for wi-fi devices, but for logistical reasons CSSD is unable to provide customized support for each specific type of device. You should be able to connect successfully to Wireless PittNet by configuring your wi-fi device according to the following specifications:

- Network SSID: **WIRELESS-PITNET**
- Security Type: **WPA-Enterprise**
- Encryption Type: **TKIP**
- Authentication Method: **PEAP**
 - **EAP-MSCHAPv2**
