POLICY: A grade below "C" is not acceptable in all courses with the prefix NUR and the

following courses:

CHEM 0910 Chemistry for the Health Professions

If a grade earned is below "C", the course must be repeated.

PROCEDURE:

Guidance for re-planning the program will be provided by the student's academic advisor.

The grade change for the students in the second degree program will occur when the change occurs for the traditional students in the course.

This requirement goes into effect:

Fall term 2013 for Freshmen NUR courses and CHEM 0910

Fall term 2014 for all Sophomore NUR courses Fall term 2015 for all Junior NUR courses Fall term 2016 for all Senior NUR courses
