1. *Standards for Nurse Anesthesia Practice* reflects current standards for practice and to improve the clarity of the document, resulting in streamlined, updated set of standards.

2. *Infection Control Guide for Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists* reflects several years of research, literature synthesis, and writing from the Infection Control Task Force. This document provides a substantial reference for CRNAs in the prevention of infection and management of patients with current infections. Topics range from care of the patient to self-care and equipment management.

3. *Scope of Nurse Anesthesia Practice* was revised. The new document integrates qualitative and quantitative data derived from the evidence-based review process, six focus groups, and an AANA membership survey to represent the contemporary and comprehensive span of nurse anesthesia practice.
