Research/Quality Improvement

Also providing STI prophylaxis in accordance with new CDC STI treatment guidelines.
- October 2020 Improving nPEP Prescribing by ED Providers for Victims of Sexual Assault: Quality Improvement Project to educate ED providers on HIV prophylaxis prescribing, provide patients with a starter pack of medications, engage nursing Case Management to assist with obtaining the rest of the prescribed medications.
