POLICY: The appropriate course is taken for thesis credit. Students electing to

conduct a thesis must register for a minimum of 6 thesis credits during their

program of study.

PROCEDURE: 1. Students register for thesis credits in their area of specialization

when developing their overview proposal, working on the thesis

and defending their thesis proposal.

2. "I" grades are given for thesis credits until the thesis has been

completed.

3. The term the thesis is satisfactorily completed, the committee chairperson submits the change of grade form to Student Affairs

and Alumni Relations to change all "I" grades to "S" grades.

4. If a student does not intend to or is unable to complete the thesis, all

previous thesis "I" grades should be changed to the "N" grade.
