POLICY: To qualify to graduate with university honors, the student must accumulate 60 University of Pittsburgh credits. University of Pittsburgh honors are designated according to the following cumulative GPA criteria:

Honor:	Cum Laude	3.25-3.49
High Honor:	Magna Cum Laude	3.50-3.74
Highest Honor:	Summa Cum Laude	3.75-4.00

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Upon receipt of the final grade report and completion of degree requirements, Student Affairs and Alumni Relations calculates the final GPA and honors.
- 2. Undergraduate nursing students with 60 or more Pitt credits are considered for university honors.
- 3. Honors are indicated on the final transcript.
