POLICY: This policy clarifies when the University of Pittsburgh School of Nursing provides refunds for a

nursing continuing professional development (NCPD) learning activity or reserves the right to cancel

an NCPD learning activity.

PROCEDURE:

Refunds: All requests to cancel a registration must be made in writing (email notification is acceptable). Any

registrations canceled less than 14 days before the learning activity are no longer eligible for a

refund.

Cancellations: The University of Pittsburgh School of Nursing reserves the right to cancel a learning activity. In the

event of a cancellation by the University of Pittsburgh School of Nursing, registrants will receive a

full refund for their registration fees.

Certificate Replacement Policy

No re-issuance of certificates will be provided without a surcharge of \$15.00, and this window of opportunity is only within six (6) months of the original issuance date provided proof of attendance and payment is on file with the School of Nursing.
