Those interested in presenting a virtual poster must complete and submit the following information prior to the abstract submission deadline:

1. Complete an Abstract Submission Form (form fields include):

- Names of *all* abstract authors
- Name of the person presenting the virtual poster
- Poster presentation title
- Poster abstract (not exceed 250 words overall); one submission link will ask for the abstract to be blinded (*no* authors listed) and the other submission link will ask for the abstract to list *all* authors
- Provide one (1) learning objective to be utilized for the contact hours evaluation process

2. Complete and submit a Biographical Information Form

3. Complete and submit a Conflict of Interest (COI) Form
